Clarifications to select questions

Q.9 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : 'A' is the correct answer. You write 'with' a pen but 'in' blue ink.

Q.18 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : 'A' is the correct answer. The word 'always' demands the use of present tense.

Q.19 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : 'C' is the correct option. The words 'right now' refer to current action.

Q.43 : Clarification : The answer should have been (A) 'window'. There is a typographical error. It should have been 'window'. We sincerely regret the error. The answer can not be 'C' as it relates to its <u>function</u> or <u>what it serves as</u> and <u>not what it is</u>. A 'means of light' can be the Sun or any other 'source of light' outside. This is the 'means for letting in' the light.

Q.44 : Ans. : (B). Clarification : The 6th and 7th line of the passage state that an Eskimo can build an 'Igloo' in an hour. So, that is the maximum time taken and is given at option 'B'. The actual time may vary within that hour, depending on capacity and other factors. Please remember, we 'comprehend' not 'report'.
