Ranking System

Top 100 Achievers

Those who fall within Overall Ranking 1 to 100, are declared as Top 100 Achievers.

State Achievers

After the top 100 ranks; from the remaining, the first 3 from every State are declared as State-wise Toppers.

Students of the same class with similar total marks can have different Overall Ranks

When more than one student of the same class score the same, ranking is calculated based on marks gained in following order of subjects: For Classes 1 & 2: Mathematics, Logical Reasoning, for Classes 3 to 5: Mathematics, Logical Reasoning & Critical Thinking and for Classes 6 to 12: Mathematics, Mathematics-2, Logical Reasoning & Critical Thinking. In addition, the time taken is also taken into consideration.

Awards are given away to students (rankers or otherwise) only if they get marks above 50%.

FAQs

I got Overall Rank 95. Why my name does not appear in the State-wise achievers' list?

State-wise ranks are awarded to toppers, only after the first 100 Top Achievers. Your rank (Overall Rank) is based on the entire participation and so is above the State-wise Ranks. Hence, it cannot appear in the State-wise achievers' list.

Note: State-wise achievers are declared excluding top 100 Ranks.

What does "--" in Rank column mean?

Marks less than 30 percent, are shown as "--".
