# Solutions for Sample Questions class: 3

### **Mental Ability**

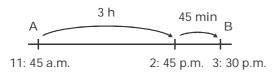
- 1. **(C)**  $123456 \div 8 = 15432$ **P** = 1, Q = 5, R = 4, S = 3 and T = 2
- 2. **(A)** '1' s in the ones place →
  1, 11, 21, 31, 41, 51, 61, 71, 81, 91, 101, 111
  '1's in the tens place →
  10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 110, 111
  '1' s in hundreds place →

100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111

$$\therefore$$
 12 + 12 + 12 = 36

Hence, 36 '1' s are used altogether.

- 3. (B) 4 girls + 2 boys share 204 stickers⇒ 6 children share 204 stickers
  - $\therefore$  Each children had 204 ÷ 6 = 34 stickers
  - $\therefore$  3 girls + 5 boys will have 34  $\times$  8
  - = 272 stickers

7. **(C)** In the given circle, the number follow a pattern in anticlockwise direction.

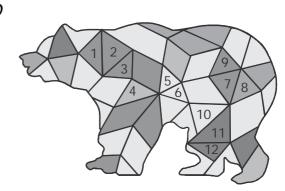
