 So the missing number is 5.

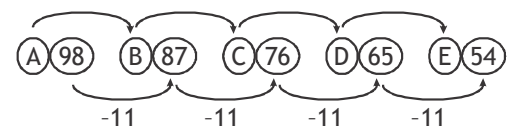

Hence, code for is ZM.

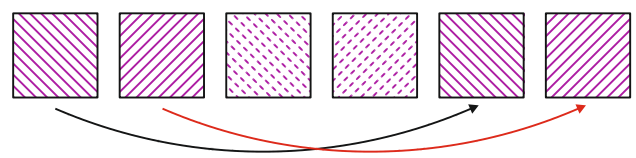
