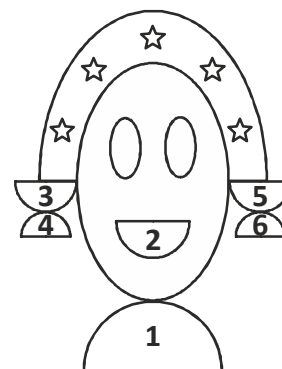

(B) Process, output, and input - Incorrect. While processing is an essential function of a computer, it occurs after input and before output. Therefore, this order is incorrect.

(C) Input, process, and output - Correct. The correct order of the three basic functions of a computer is input, process, and output.

Input refers to the data or information that is entered into the computer.

Process involves the manipulation and processing of the input data by the computer's central processing unit (CPU) according to programmed instructions.

Output refers to the results or processed information that is produced by the computer and presented to the user, such as displayed on a screen, printed on paper, or transmitted to another device.

(D) Input, output, and process - Incorrect. The correct sequence is input, process, and output, not input, output, and process.
