Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 The words are: (i) Lemon [R], (ii) Wrench [S], (iii) Eagle [P], (iv) Dice [Q]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 02 The words are : (i) Scout [Q], (ii) Drum [S], (iii) Hunter [P], (iv) Peanuts [R]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.
- 05 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Sauce' can be a countable noun as it has a plural form : 'sauces'.
- 06 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'Pear' is a fruit & that's its plural.
- 15 Option (B) is the correct answer. A comparative degree is used only for comparison between two and not more.
- 20 Option (C): 'the' is the correct answer. When a noun (here *bicycle*) used once with its article (here 'a') is used again in that sentence with a reference to it, it becomes a particular one and hence we use 'the', a definite article for it.
- 23 Option (C) is the correct answer. Only a 'goat' has horns.
- 24 Option (D) is the correct answer; 'steaming', 'fried' and 'running' are adjectives of 'rice' and 'train' respectively.
