## Explanations and answers to select questions

- 13 Option (B) is the correct answer. The three words are: Mane, Mare and Mean.
- 14 Option (D) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Occasion'.
- 23 Option (C) is the correct answer. The adverb 'already', means 'before now or before a particular time in the past'. That means the action has been fully completed. This can be expressed by using present/past perfect tense. Option (D) though a past perfect, doesn't have a suitable verb.
- 24 Option (D) is the correct answer. Option (B) can't be used as we have 'to', not 'and' to pair with.
- 25 Option (B) is the correct answer. The reference is to people from a particular region/continent, Europe, as a class; and to specify that, 'The' should be used. It refers to the people, a plural (see do not); if it were 'does not' referring to a single person from a region, the article used would have been 'A'.
- 28 Option (D) is the correct answer. The modal 'should' is used for giving advice especially to show what is right, appropriate, etc., and so should be used here, as the context suggests.
- 29 Option (C) is the correct answer. To enthrall is to interest strongly and to exhort is to urge strongly.
- 36 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'knowledgeable' means 'knowing a lot', so a story can't be 'knowledgeable', a person can be.
