Explanations and answers to select questions

- 03 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Bachelor'.
- 11 Option (D) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Waive'.
- 15 Option (C) is the correct answer. Article 'a' before 'screeching' compels the use of a countable noun 'sound'.
- 22 Option (A) is the correct answer. Article 'the' because 'light' is a particular one the speaker is referring to for the action of turning on, and for book 'a', because it is not referred to.
- 31 Option 'B' : 'PQRS' is the correct answer. The corrections are shown in brackets and by striking out : People is (are) awaiting for the arrival to (of) the cheap (chief) guest.
- 41 Option (A) is the correct answer. Because they can't breath under water, though they can hold breath under water, for a long time. So they live only on land. A whale too can't breath underwater as it has no gills, but it can't live on land and so is an aquatic.
