Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (B) is the correct answer. Its homophone is : Ate.
- 03 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : Biscuit.
- 05 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Coup' is pronounced as 'Coo'.
- 06 Option (D) is the correct answer. A library of books.
- 12 Option (D) is the correct answer. The words 'red meat' and 'green salad' are compound nouns, so, there is only one adjective, 'fried'.
- 20 Option (C) is the correct answer. The phrasal verb 'look (something) up' means 'to look for information in a dictionary, reference book, computer, etc.'
- 21 Option (B) is the correct answer. The sounds produced by the first syllables of 'RTC', 'auto-rickshaw' and 'unidentified' are as in 'arc', 'outer' and 'anna' respectively, all vowel sounds, so 'an' at all the blanks.
- 23 Option (B) is the correct answer. Only that cannot be a noun.
- 24 Option (D) is the correct answer. The first pair is of synonyms, and only 'finite' makes the second pair similar in manner.
- 25 Option (C) is the correct answer. There is no change of tense in the reported speech without quotes, when the reporting verb is in present tense (*says* here).
- 26 Option (B) is the correct answer. It represents 'someone'. Pronoun 'them' is used to represent a singular noun when the gender of that noun is not known.
- 33 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'Livestock' covers only these.
