## Explanations and answers to select questions

- 03 Option (C) is the correct answer. Its homophone is : 'Shoo'.
- 05 Option (A) is the correct answer. It is 'always'.
- 07 Option (C) is the correct answer. The syllables are : 'con-fec-tion-er-y'.
- 08 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : 'Millennium'.
- 09 Option (D) is the correct answer. The the four words are : inlets, listen, silent, tinsel.
- 10 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the same spelling for its plural.
- 15 Option (B) is the correct answer. The subject is 'layer', a singular and it doesn't rule the earth.
- 16 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'One of' so a plural is required.
- 25 Option (C) is the correct answer. The phrase 'as well as' is not a conjunction and neither does it function as one. That leaves 'Krishna temple' the singular subject to agree with the verb. And 'was' can't fit in.
- 30 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'Ampersand' is a symbol for 'and'; and a cipher is for a zero.
- 31 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the only one that changes its spelling with tense forms.
- 32 Option (D) is the correct answer. The reporting verb (*will say*) being in future tense, there is no change of tense in the reported speech without quotes.
- 33 Option (C) is the correct answer. The statement being a universal truth, there is no change of tense in the reported speech without quotes.
