**Explanations and answers to select questions**

- 06 Option (D) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : 'Really'.
- 09 Option (B) is the correct answer. The five adjectives are : unknown, my, six, uniform and corked. Possessive adjectives in English (my) refer to the possessor and not to the thing possessed.
- 10 Option (D) is the correct answer. The four words are : Gain, Gait, Gnat, Gnaw.
- 11 Option (A) is the correct answer. Chortle = Chuckle + Snort.
- 13 Option (C) is the correct answer. They are : En-thu-si-asm.
- 25 Option (C) is the correct answer. The first syllable of 'unit' produces a consonant sound as in 'you' so 'a' and because we refer to a particular type of people 'invalid', 'the'.
- 27 Option (C) is the correct answer. When the subject is made up of nouns joined by 'or', the verb agrees with the last noun. So, the verb needs to agree with 'brothers', a plural.
- 28 Option (A) is the correct answer. The phrase 'as well as' is not a conjunction, neither does it work like one. That leaves only the singular subject 'cow' to agree with the verb.
- 29 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is also an adjective.
- 41 'Brook' applies there in the 1st paragraph as a synonym of 'Creek' correctly and so option (B) is the correct answer.
- 42 Option (C) is the correct answer. The story is about only one summer, not summers. And it is not only about summer activities.
