## Explanations and answers to select questions

- 06 Option (D) is the correct answer. The four additional/other words are : hares, hears, rheas, shear.
- 07 Option (C) is the correct answer. It also means a military vehicle or a large can.
- 13 Option (B) is the correct answer. The adjectives are : 'fed up', 'his' and 'fair weather'. Possesive adjectives in English (*his*) refer to the possessor and not to the thing possessed.
- 15 Option (B) is the correct answer. The syllables are : Ap-point-ment.
- 23 Option (D) is the correct answer. A relative pronoun (*that* here) agrees with its antecedent in *gender*, *number* and *person*. The antecedent of *that* is 'books', not 'one', so 'have', not 'has'.
- 24 Option (C) is the correct answer. This is a 'second conditional' : If + past simple (studied), would + infinitive (succeed)'.
- 26 Option (C) is the correct answer. That makes it a correct parallel structure, 'to read' and 'to appreciate'.
- 29 Option (C) is the correct answer. The possessive adjective 'their' leads to that.
- 31 Option (D) is the correct answer. The pronunciations of first syllables of 'NCC' and 'intelligent' are as in 'entry' and 'invention' respectively, both vowel sounds, so 'an'.
- 33 Option (B) is the correct answer. Only that is not a homonym like the others. So, it is not about what type of tool that is.
- 35 Option (D) is the correct answer. As the reporting verb (*says*) is in the present tense, there is no change of tense in the reported speech without quotes.
