Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 The words are : (i) Pencil [S], (ii) Apple [R], (iii) Spade [P], (iv) Stapler [Q]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.
- 02 The words are : (i) Yawning [Q], (ii) Swans [R], (iii) Prawn [S], (iv) Wallet [P]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 06 Option (B) : 'Lotus' is the correct answer. Option (D) 'Mars' even when considered as the name of a planet, is a proper noun.
- 07 Option (C) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Bungalow'.
- 09 Option (C) is the correct answer. A 'Board' of directors.
- 13 Option (C) : 'An, a' is the correct answer. Depending on the sound the first syllable of a word produces, we decide to use article 'a' or 'an'. Here, in 'honourable' the sound produced by the first syllable is that of a vowel as in 'order', hence 'an', and 'a' for the second blank because the sound produced by the first syllable of 'horse' is that of a consonant as in 'hot'. Option (A) is unfit for the blank, because the 't' in 'the' is not in capital.
- 18 Option (B) is the correct answer. The verb 'shouted' directs us to use the exclamation mark. The close inverted commas naturally follow.
- 23 Option (C) is the odd one. It is the only one that cannot fly, all others can.
