## Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'Means' is the same spelling for singular and plural.
- 02 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Weird'.
- 03 Option (C) is the correct answer. All others are nouns (plurals).
- 04 Option (B) is the correct answer. Only it forms past tense by adding 'ed'.
- 08 Option (D) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Won'.
- 12 Option (D) is the correct answer. Its masculine gender is 'Drake'.
- 21 Option (D) is the correct answer. As the first syllable of 'ATM' produces a vowel sound as in 'Aim', we use 'an'; and as 'money' is an uncountable noun we don't use 'a' or 'an'. Article 'the' can't be used as we are not referring to particular/specific money.
- 23 Option (C) is the correct answer. The presence of 'than' demands the use of a comparative degree at the blank.
- 25 Option (D) is the odd one. It is the only one that is not a verb.
- 27 Option (B) is the correct answer. The four stages are : egg, caterpillar, chrysalis and butterfly.
