Explanations and answers to select questions

- 04 Option (A) is the correct answer. It is an adjective that describes the size/shape of someone/something and also a noun meaning the white or yellow substance stored under the skin of animals/humans.
- 11 Option (A) is the correct answer. The four adjectives are : 'his', 'white', 'fast' and 'unruly'. Possessive adjectives in English (his) refer to the possessor and not to the thing possessed. The word 'fast' doesn't talk about the manner of running but talks about the noun horse and so is not an adverb but is an adjective.
- 12 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : 'Embarrass'.
- 13 Option (C) is the correct answer. The syllables are : bou-tique.
- 22 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Many a student' means 'many times one student' or 'many students'. But when put as 'many a student' it takes them singly, so 'has'.
- 23 Option (D) is the correct answer. As an adjective, 'false' is followed by preposition 'to' or 'of'. Here, he is false 'of' something, 'heart'.
- 26 Option (B) is the correct answer. The pronunciation of first syllable of 'STD', is as in 'ace', so 'an' and 'repairs' being a plural, 'no article' for the second blank.
- 28 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Parrot' and 'mimic' are synonyms and so are 'dog' and 'hound'.
- 31 Option (C) is the correct answer. A future continuous cannot be changed to passive form.
- 32 Option (A) is the correct answer. Only that is a verb too.
- 34 Option (D) is the correct answer. The reporting verb (*will say*) being in future tense, there is no change of tense in the reported speech without quotes.
