Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (C) is the correct answer. Its singular is : Opus.
- 04 Option (D) is the correct answer. As a verb and as a noun, it has quite different meanings.
- 05 Option (C) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : Buffalo.
- 10 Option (B) is the correct answer. The two adjectives are 'tempting' and 'blue'.
- 12 Option (D) is the correct answer. It is 'Pang' : 'Pain+Sting'.
- 14 Option (A) is the correct answer. The six additional/other words are : carets, caters, caster, reacts, recast and traces.
- 15 Option (C) is the correct answer. The syllables are : Om-nip-o-tent.
- 23 Option (A) is the correct answer. When 'either' . . . 'or' is used, the subject closer to the verb (toppers) determines the number of the verb. Hence, 'are'.
- 27 Option (B) is the correct answer. The words 'France' and 'Europe' being proper nouns, do not take any article.
- 29 Option (D) is the correct answer. The sentence with <u>corrections</u> and (errors) is : The <u>principal</u> (principle) along with teachers <u>is</u> (are) going on strike.
- 30 Option (C) is the correct answer. As the reporting verb is in the present tense (*says*), there is no change of tense in the reported speech.
- 31 Option (B) is the correct answer. As the statement is a universal truth, there is no change of tense in the reported speech.
- 33 Option (D) is the correct answer. It is not possible to have a passive voice construction in future continuous tense, which the sentence uses.
- 38 Option (B) is the correct answer. The question asks 'how', not 'where'.
