Explanations and answers to select questions

- 05 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Duchess'.
- 07 Answer (D): 'Far' is the only correct answer. The correct irreversible word pair is 'Far and wide'. What you find on a Google search is not necessarily true, correct and/or authentic.
- 08 Option (B) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Stalk'.
- 12 Option (C) is the correct answer. The 5 syllables are : Ex-am-i-na-tion.
- 15 Option (B) is the correct answer. The animals are mentioned as 'wild and free' and so cannot be in homes, stables and zoos.
- 17 Option (B) is the correct answer. Only 'herbivores' provides a parrallel comparison to 'carnivores'.
- 23 Option (D) is the correct answer. The speaker refers to a specific bus, one for which they were waiting, so 'The' for the first blank. For the second blank, the single syllable word 'half' produces a consonant sound as in 'hard', so article 'a'; and for the third blank 'an', as the single syllable word 'hour' produces a vowel sound as in 'our'.
- 25 Option (D) is the correct answer. RQPS would read as: The stream wasn't very big but it was deep.
- 28 Option (C) is the correct answer. The question asks how many friends Sarah went 'with', which means those other than Sarah. The three friends were: Rosy, Jenny and Tom.
- 30 Option (C) is the correct answer. Please refer to the sentence, 'She loved the feeling . . . when pushed by Rosy in turn. The idiom 'in turn' used therein means, 'one after the other in a particular order', so it is obvious that Rosy did.
