Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is the plural of 'opus'.
- 02 Option (D) is the correct answer. It's an area outside a building and also a unit of measurement.
- 03 Option (C) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : 'Antarctic'.
- 07 Option (C) is the correct answer. Slang = Slovenly + Language.
- 11 Option (D) is the correct answer. The four words are : ester, reset, steer, terse.
- 12 Option (B) is the correct answer. Mark the spelling, it's not 'Spacious'.
- 14 Option (C) is the correct answer. The six adjectives are : my, wet, crispy, dry, timely and hot. *Note* : Possessive adjectives in English (*my*) refer to the possessor and not to the thing possessed.
- 23 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is a 'zero conditional' (If + simple present, . . . simple present) with the placement of clauses reversed.
- 24 Option (C) is the correct answer. The mention 'this' relates the action to the present time, so we need to use a form of present tense, agreeing with the plural subject, 'many people'.
- 29 Option (B) is the correct answer, because the first syllables of 'heir' and 'MLA', both produce a vowel sound as in 'air' and 'aim' respectively.
- 31 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the only one that can be a noun too.
- 32 Option (C) is the correct answer. The first pair 'Track' and 'Path', are synonyms, and so 'Mould' a synonym of 'Fungus' for the second pair.
