Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Fete' is pronounced as 'Fate', so rhymes with 'Date'.
- 02 Option (B) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Feint'.
- 04 Option (D) is the correct answer. The plural can also be 'swine'.
- 07 Option (A) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Amulet'.
- 08 Option (D) is the correct answer. Bit = Binary+Digit.
- 10 Option (D) is the correct answer. The two adjectives are: 'friendly' and 'lonely'.
- 11 Option (B) is the correct answer. They are : il-lu-sion.
- 12 Option (C) is the correct answer. The five other words are : opts, post, pots, stop and tops.
- 21 Option (A) is the correct answer. The phrase 'together with' is not a conjunction and neither does it work so. That leaves the verb, only a singular subject (Ana) to agree with.
- 22 Option (D) is the correct answer. The subject is 'Neither', meaning 'not either' or 'not any', a singular.
- 24 Option (D) is the correct answer. The pronunciation of 's' is as in 'ace', and the pronuncia-tion of the first syllable of 'apostrophe' is as in 'affordable', both vowel sounds, so 'an'.
- 25 Option (C) is the correct answer. Arithmetic expressions require singular verbs.
- 31 Option (B) is the correct answer. As the reporting verb (*says*) is in the present tense, there is no change of tense in the reported speech.
- 32 Option (D) is the correct answer. As the staetement is a universal truth, there is no change of tense in the reported speech.
