### Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 The words are : (i) Ruler [R], (ii) Seagull [S], (iii) Coconut [P], (iv) Couch [Q]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.
- 02 The words are : (i) Swan [S], (ii) Whale [P], (iii) Screw [Q], (iv) Claw [R]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 09 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is the plural of a common noun, 'pond'.
- 11 Option (C) is the correct answer. A 'deck' of cards.
- 12 Option (A) is the correct answer. It has the same spelling for its plural.
- 14 Option (C) is the correct answer. The word 'sew' is pronounced as 'so'. Please refer to the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 10th edition published in 2020. A note stating the same is already printed in our communication as regards the exam.
- 19 Option (D) is the correct answer. As the first syllable of 'hard-working' produces a consonant sound as in 'harm', we use the article 'a', and as the first syllable of 'honest' produces a vowel sound as in 'onset', we use the article 'an'.
- 20 Option (C) is the correct answer. Here the question deals only with singular and plural and the word 'bison' has the same spelling for its plural. Please refer to the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 10th edition published in 2020. A note stating the same is already printed in our communication as regards the exam.
- 23 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the only one that cannot live on land and also the only one that is a mammal.
- 25 Option (D) is the correct answer. The letter 'H' appears two letters (I, J) before the letter 'K' in alphabetical order. So, 'Hit' appears before (Kid). Hence the alphabetical order mentioned in the option (D) is correct. If need be, please refer to the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 10th edition published in 2020. A note stating the same is already printed in our communication as regards the exam.
- 32 Option (D) is the correct answer. A child would run around to find a place for hiding. That is quite natural.
- 34 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Bounce' is not an exclamation. You may refer to the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 10th edition published in 2020. A note stating the same is already printed in our communication as regards the exam.
