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Explanations and answers to select questions

01 The words are : (i) Ruler [R], (ii) Seagull [S], (iii) Coconut [P], (iv) Couch [Q]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.

02 The words are : (i) Swan [S], (ii) Whale [P], (iii) Screw [Q], (iv) Claw [R]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.

09 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is the plural of a common noun, 'pond'.

11 Option (C) is the correct answer. A 'deck' of cards.

12 Option (A) is the correct answer. It has the same spelling for its plural.

14 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Sew' is pronounced as 'sow', so 'low' is correct.

19 Option (D) is the correct answer. As the first syllable of 'hard-working' produces a consonant sound as in 'harm', we use the article 'a', and as the first syllable of 'honest' produces a vowel sound as in 'onset', we use the article 'an'.

20 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Moose' and 'bison' both have the same spellings for their plurals.

23 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the only one that cannot live on land and also the only one that is a mammal.
