Explanations and answers to select questions

- 02 Option (A) is the correct answer. It is the same spelling for its plural.
- 03 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Incidentally'.
- 04 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'Swift' is a small bird with long narrow wings. No other option can be a common noun. Please refer to the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 10th edition published in 2020. A note stating the same is already printed in our communication as regards the exam.
- 05 Option (C) is the correct answer. Only that forms its past tense by adding 'ed' at the end.
- 07 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Neigh' is pronounced as 'Nay' and so, it rhymes with option (C) : Pay. Please refer to the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 10th edition published in 2020. A note stating the same is already printed in our communication as regards the exam.
- 08 Option (D) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Led'. Please note that the question asks 'Which option is a homophone ?' and not a 'homonym'.
- 11 Option (C) is the correct answer. The 3 verbs are : cast, hurt and blind.
- 18 Option (B) is the correct answer. They are twins. That means only two in number and so 'between', and not 'among'.
- 19 Option (C) is the correct answer. As the single syllable word 'NCC' produces a vowel sound as in 'Envy', we use 'an'; and as 'army' is referred to as a particular army, the part of a country's armed forces, we use 'the'.
- 24 Option (B) is the odd one. It is the only one that can be a verb too.
- 25 Option (C) is the correct answer. What action we carry out with a spade is 'dig', and what action we carry out with a shovel, is 'scoop'.
- 27 Option (C) is the correct answer. The four types are : rose, daisy, sunflower and tulip. The question asks the number of types of flowers in the secret garden; and it is quite clear from the text that only four types of flowers are mentioned therein.
- 28 Option (B) is the only correct answer as it offers the only correct reasoning to the 'because' in that question.
- 30 Option (D) is the only correct answer. It is used to express the emotion of 'amazement' and so is the correct answer.
- 33 Option (C) is the only correct answer. Please refer to the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 10th edition published in 2020. A note stating the same is already printed in our communication as regards the exam.
- 35 Option (C) is the only correct answer, obviously in reply to the dentist's question. The dentist is making a statement after 'examining' the teeth, which relates to the condition of the teeth and not merely the looks (appearance) of the teeth which relate to 'admiring' not 'examining'.
