Explanations and answers to select questions

- 02 Option (B) is the correct answer. The homophones for the other 3 are: heal, shoo and sole.
- 08 Option (A) is the correct answer. Bash = Bang+Smash.
- 09 Option (C) is the correct answer. The three other words are : pintos, pitons and points.
- 11 Option (C) is the correct answer. The two adjectives are : 'friendly' and 'elderly'.
- 21 Option (C) is the correct answer. The verb 'rescued' leads to that.
- 26 Option (D) is the correct answer. The phrase 'together with' is not a conjunction and neither does it work as one. That leaves the verb, only a singular subject (mother) to agree with.
- 27 Option (B) is the correct answer. The single-syllabled word 'NRI' produces a vowel sound as in 'En', so 'an'; the first syllables of the words 'european' and 'unique' both produce a consonant sound as in 'you', so 'a'.
- 29 Option (C) is the correct answer. A future continuous cannot be changed to passive form.
- 30 Option (D) is the correct answer. The reporting verb (*says*) being in present tense, there is no change of tense in the reported speech without quotes.
- 34 Option (D) is the correct answer. Only that is a homophone.
