Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (A) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Awkward'.
- 07 Option (C) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Faun'. 'Calf' is a homonym.
- 08 Option (D) is the correct answer. The other words: mates, meats, tames, teams.
- 14 Option (C) is the correct answer. The five syllables are: il-lu-mi-nat-ed.
- 22 Option (B) is the correct answer. The phrase 'as well as' seems to join the subjects, 'bull' and 'mule', but it doesn't work as a conjunction and hence the verb agrees with the subject first mentioned, 'bull'; hence 'is'.
- 23 Option (C) is the correct answer. Because the fact that hand-washing prevents infection is a universal truth, it doesn't change with time, and so it is expressed in simple present.
- 25 Option (B) is the correct answer. The sounds the first syllables of 'HMT', 'uncle' and 'antique' produce are as in 'etch', 'our' and 'ant' respectively, all vowel sounds, so 'an' for each.
- 26 Option (D) is the correct answer. The verb is : steal (stolen). 'help' is a noun here as in domestic help.
- 27 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is a '2nd conditional': 'If + present simple (don't leave), will + infinitive (miss)', with the position of clauses interchanged.
- 29 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Sham' is 'Fake'; 'Brig' is a 'Prison', on a warship.
- 31 Option (B) is the correct answer. Transition to passive voice of present perfect continuous is not possible.
